Dear parents, carers and Friends of Daniel's Den,

So, our last sessions have taken place and our summer holiday has begun. Time to write our summer newsletter and reflect on this past term.

It has been a pleasure to welcome so many new families – in this past term alone we have welcomed 172 new children and 197 adults. Thank you for registering on our database – you are receiving this newsletter via email because you have registered. As we are a charity, we need to demonstrate our impact to funders and being able to show where people live, the age of the children, number of attendees in each session etc helps greatly.

Our venues

The Lewinson, Willesden -

We are delighted to have a new carpet! The children and volunteers were all involved in raising funds for Daniel's Den during our fundraising month – from bouncing on trampolines, baking cakes and selling plants – what a wonderful team effort.

St Michael and All Angels, Stonebridge -

They welcomed lots of new families including a 2week-old baby in the last session. They've really enjoyed using their outdoor space for sports day.

Mandhata Youth and Community Association, Wembley –

We have enjoyed the space, location and free parking in this venue. However, it is expensive and under review.

St Cuthberts, North Wembley -

The numbers attending the sessions has grown and everyone loves to join in the singing session with Gill on her violin. They too have a lovely outdoor space which Linda loves to use as much as she can.

Chalkhill Community Centre, Chalkhill -

This venue is such a blessing to local families and there is a real sense of community being developed.

St Andrews, Sudbury -

There have been a number of goodbyes this term as families have moved out of the area – always a time of mixed emotions.

The Ascension, Wembley -

This space was launched on May 12th, 2022, and is ideal for running a group. We are looking forward to welcoming the new Bishop of Willesden to our group in a one-off pop-up session in July.



Latymer Community Church, Ladbroke Grove -

It has been a joy to see the numbers growing in this venue and many tears were shed by the children on the last day of term when they received their certificates to mark the occasion of them moving onto nursery. This really demonstrates the impact Daniel's Den has on the lives of our children.

The Yellow, Wembley Park -

Due to large numbers and not wanting to turn people away led us to open a second session straight after the first one – thanks to funding from Quintain. We were able to stop the booking system, and both sessions are now a walk in. We've welcomed several visitors to the sessions including Christine from Little Village, two researchers from the Children's Commissioner, Hannah from The National Lottery (our main funders) and Carol from the London Network of Parent and Toddler Groups.

New groups

From our data, as well as your comments, we knew there was a gap in provision in the Preston Road and Kingsbury/Kenton areas.

- 1) We were approached by Rev Jacqueline Shalloe about opening a group in her church The Ascension, Wembley. After several meetings and discussions, the new group opened on May 12th, and it has been wonderful to offer a safe space within walking distance to families in the local community off Preston Road. There is a lovely team comprising of Jacqui and church members Tracy, Honora and Sheila. Raduca is a local parent and is part of the team too.
- 2) We are delighted to say we have funding from NCIL to start and run a group in Kenton/Kingsbury area and plans are well under way to launch this in September. Details to follow.
- 3) We are also looking into a potential new group in Alperton but need to secure the funding for this.
